Frequently asked questions about the pre participation physicals

Q. [Who needs a physical?](#)

A. Any athlete from Grades 7-12 who play sports for their schools are required to have a pre-season Physical. This must be done prior to participation in the first game .

Q. [Where do we go?](#)

A. Beacon has two offices servicing all of greater Cincinnati, Northern Kentucky and Southeastern Indiana. Locations and directions to the nearest office are found on this web site.

Q. [What do I bring to the physicals?](#)

A. State requires a form, Ohio State forms are provided, but must be completed by parent or guardian.

Q. [Do I need to be there with my student athlete?](#)

A. Yes, an adult is required to sign the form for the athlete, it is imperative that someone over the age of 18 is present at the time of registration.

Q. [What does someone wear to these physicals?](#)

A. Shorts, shirt, and slip on shoes, no jeans, no sweat pants, shoes and socks are removed for the physical.

Q. [Who does these physicals?](#)

A. There is a staff of professionals from Orthopaedic surgeons to trainers, physical therapists, physician assistants trained to complete the physicals.

Q. [What is the cost for these physicals?](#)

A. The cost for the physical is \$20.00 payable by cash or check. Private insurance will not be filed for this service.

Q. [Where does the money go from these physicals?](#)

A. \$10.00 per athlete will be returned to the school's athletic department for sports medicine supplies

Q. [Do I need to call and let someone know my student athlete will be coming?](#)

A. Appointments are not necessary there may be delays during the high volume time but the process should only take 45 minutes to one hour for the physical.
